

# Dale Uniform & Dress Code Policy.

## Tops

The **ONLY** shirts allowed are White, Black or Red Polo shirts, or Dale Spirit shirts. Even if you're wearing a sweatshirt, you **MUST** have a uniform shirt on underneath.



**\*\*College shirts may be worn on Thursdays**

## Bottoms

No color requirement

- Pants/shorts must fit at the waist. **NO sagging allowed**. Sagging pants/shorts will be confiscated and made a parent pick up.
- Shorts/Skirts: must fit mid-thigh, or below finger tips when arms are held at the side.
- Rips/tears: must be below the finger tips when arms held at side



## Sweatshirts

- Sweatshirts from feeder elementary or colleges are OK
- Dale sweatshirts can be purchased in the Main Office
- Hood must be off, unless it is raining.



## Shoes

Shoes must fully cover all parts of the foot; including toes and heel.





# Dale Uniform & Dress Code Policy.

## Tops

No tank tops, tube tops, crop tops.  
Tops must always have sleeves.



No midriff showing at any time,



No oversized shirts, tops must always fit.



## Bottoms

No sagging at all. If your underwear or undershorts are visible, you're sagging.



Shorts must be longer than your finger tips when arms are at your side. Rips/tears/holes must also be lower than your fingertips.



No bike shorts



PE clothes are not allowed to be worn outside of PE class



Pajamas are not allowed unless it is a designated spirit day



No ProClub pants, sweats, shorts. No other brand designed to look like ProClub

## Shoes

Footwear that is NEVER allowed: Crocs, slides, sandals, slippers, any house shoe





# Dale Uniform & Dress Code Policy

## **Accessories**

Only headwear for religious reasons are allowed.



- No inappropriate logos: anything depicting drugs, alcohol, weapons etc.
- Jewelry that is deemed unsafe, as decided by Administration.
- No sunglasses
- No belt buckles with initials, inappropriate graphics or language. No wallet chains, any accessory with spikes or excessive metal on it.
- No current gang related attire, as decided by Administration.

# **Dress Code Procedures**

- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian and the student to be dressed appropriately for school, every day.
- If your student is dress coded, the incident will be recorded, and they will call home every time. It is expected that the parent/guardian will bring the student a uniform shirt, or they may buy one over the phone.
- Numerous Dress Code violations will result in progressive disciplinary action. Including, but not limited to detention, exclusion from playing sports, exclusion from attending dances, etc.
